Farm fresh produce and a variety of delicious food products will be featured at Long Grove's weekly Farmers Market, scheduled to debut on Sunday, June 13. The Farmers Market will run from 8 am to 1 pm every Sunday from June 13 through October 17. It will feature a variety of local and Midwest growers with bountiful summer fruits and vegetables, fresh made Artesian breads, made-to-order crepes, fresh bagels, sugar-free pastries and cookies, gourmet specialty foods, juices, meats and more.

The Farmers Market is located at Towner Green, across the street from The Village Tavern, in Long Grove historic Village. On festival weekends, the market will move to The Hotel parking lot, just north of Towner Green.

In addition to fresh produce, foods and flowers, Long Grove's Farmers Market will feature children's entertainment and different one-of-a-kind artisan demonstrations each week. Local charities will have an opportunity to participate.



The Farmers Market is a natural extension of Long Grove's heritage as a farming community and the increasing commitment to purchasing locally grown produce and goods.
